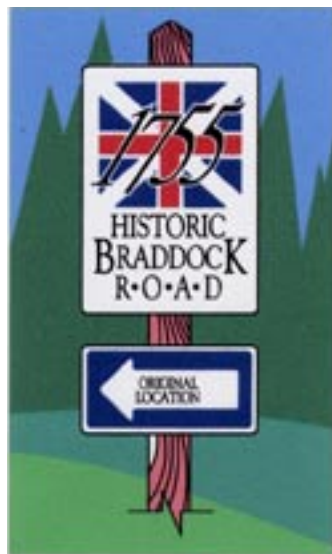
We ask you to support our endeavors to mark Braddock's Trail at Jumonville for our children & grandchildren, so they can hear the stories of how this great nation was born.

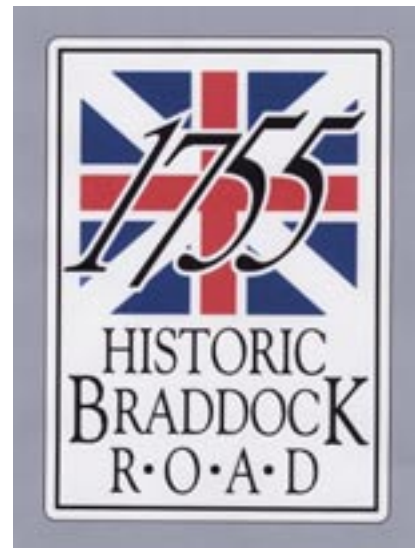
As you would agree this beautiful image will portray
